Key Scripture: John 13:31-35, Galatians 2:20, & 2 Corinthians 5:14-15

Key Characters: Jesus & the Disciples

Highlights:

- Love comes from God...the love that unites people comes from the great uniter Jesus Christ.
- The cross was the most unifying event of all human history.
- Don't just love people...love people as Jesus loved people.

CREATE CONVERSATION

1. In your opinion, what is the root cause of division and segregation in the world today?
2. From the passage in John 13, what kind of glory was Jesus referring to, and how did it relate to the cross?
3. We often see the Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit as 3 separate autonomous persons, but they are ALL three persons united as one God. How are they one, yet 3 distinct persons? Is it possible to fully understand the Trinity, why or why not?
4. If Jesus was 100% man but was also 100% God, what significance does that bring to when Jesus washed the disciples feet at the Passover Feast?
5. In Galatians 2:20, Paul talks about being united with Christ in his death and in his life. What does that mean? And according to Paul, was everyone united with him?
6. Who is Jesus Christ to you (Is he God, just a man, a prophet, etc.)? And in light of who Jesus is to you, what do you believe about his love for humanity?
